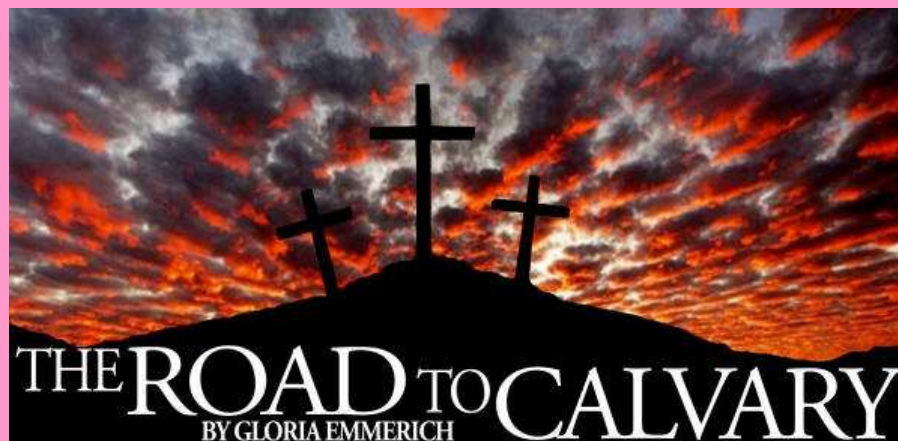


The Gift of Love
